Chibombo's Momboshi only nurse appeals for more personnel

is a big challenge for her to attend to over 19,000 people single handedly. And chief Chamuka of the Lenje people of Chibombo

district says it is not normal for one nurse to attend to thousands of people.

Meanwhile, a maternity waiting house and equipment worth over K350 million has been donated to Momboshi

(TICO). During the official handover of a maternity ward on Friday, Momboshi health post nurse-in-charge Ivy Chiyota Makumba said she had no time to rest as she attends to patients most of the time.

"I do not rest, I even fail to go to church because people follow me at church, just imagine! It does not matter whether it is during the day or night, I still have to attend to patients," said Makumba.

Chief Chamuka appealed to the government to send

more nurses to the health post.

"We are hoping that government will try by all means to at least send even one or two nurses to help our only nurse within sixty days. This nurse seated here works everyday and does not rest at all," he said.

Chief Chamuka wondered how the facilities donated by TICO would benefit the people of Momboshi if there was only one nurse at the health post.
